 - Casey/Ed suggested that we build the baseline in advance of the repository migration
 - A proposal is being drafted for Community Review. Will be posted in the Proposal section of the wiki.

Election

- Technical Representative Seats: 5
 - Current Election Mechanics limits the number of each Represented Group to 1 per Organization.
 - Self-Nominated Eligible Candidates: 5
 - Eligible Winners from Candidate pool: 4

 - Maximum number of seats is 3
 - Self-Nominated Eligible Candidates: 4
