

# Project Page Templates

## How to create a Project Page from Template:

1. Read all instructions first. 😊
2. Check to see if a Project Page has been created for you in the navigation bar on the left-hand side under one of the "Project Categories" i.e. Kernel, Service, Support, Application, etc
  - a. If the Page exists but does not have the template format, please remove or rename it and notify [Casey Cain](#) so that he can delete the page.
3. Create a new Project Page using this Macro: [Create New Project Page](#)
  - a. Complete the Project information and adjust the fields as necessary
  - b. Click the "Page Tree Icon"
    - i. [blocked URL](#)
    - ii. In the left-hand navigation bar of the "Set Page Location" window, click "Browse"
    - iii. Navigate to Tungsten Fabric Projects
    - iv. Select the appropriate Project Category
      1. Kernel Projects
      2. Protocol Projects
      3. Support Projects
      4. \*\* Etc \*\*
    - v. Click "Move" in the bottom right of the "Set Page Location" window.
    - vi. **If you don't see the page tree icon, try clicking the ... on the top right of the page and selecting 'Move'.**
      1. **If that is still not visible to you make sure you're signed in or contact [Casey Cain](#)**
  - c. Click the "tag" icon next to the "Set Page Location" icon from the previous step
    - i. Add a tag/label to your Project page that you will use on your project page and all sub-pages
    - ii. Follow the format of 'projectname'-project
  - d. Once you've completed the page, click Save in the bottom Right
4. Click the "Share" button in the upper right-hand corner of the Project Page and copy the Confluence "Share Link"
  - a. **Do not use the page URL from the browser navigation bar - Always use the "Share Link"**
5. Update the "[Projects](#)" page with your "Quick Project Info" including a link to your Project Page "Share Link" that you got from the previous step.
