Infra Updates

- Chandra Dasari and Vanessa Valderrama talked about how the LF is cleaning up the gerrit permissions, committer promotions process, and migration to the LF Single Sign-on.
 - Will be presenting more detail and self-service and repo creation on 04 Mar 2021 at the TSC meeting.
- A discussion ensued around project mapping to repositories so that permissions can be effectively managed.
 - Permissions for PTLs and Committers need to be mapped to a repository.
 - $^{\circ}$ Logically right now it is difficult for the community to associate a Project to a Repo
 - To prevent blocking of active development, the community should associate a PTL and an initial set of committers to the existing repositories.
 - The community can then in the future properly associate a project to a specific repository as they decide the permissions should be logically separated.
